

Share Jobs & Internships with multiple WIPCCC Schools

Employers can now share their job and internship postings with multiple Wisconsin private and independent colleges through Purple Briefcase. Purple Briefcase is an online career network that helps employers, students, alumni and career staff connect. Through it, you will be able to:

- Post and manage job and internship opportunities for multiple campuses
- Register for the annual WorkForce Career & Internship Fair (held each February)
- Create a visual profile for your company that is searchable by WIPCCC students and alumni, and lets them get to know your organization better

To set-up your free account and begin posting:

- select "New Employer" on the <u>Purple Briefcase login page</u>
- after creating a free account, select "My Schools" -> "Request a school connection" -> and enter school code WIPC120
- begin posting jobs and internships by selecting the "Add a Job" tab
- register for the annual WorkForce Career & Internship Fair by selecting the "My Events" tab

Postings will be sent to each of our participating schools, where they can be accessed by students and alumni. Schools currently using Purple Briefcase include:
